

- Assessment recording was sporadic which hindered pupil progress





What did we do and how?




We invest a lot in developing our children and sharing CPD. Feedback received during an independent, external observation...

NQT teacher leading Y2 outdoor lesson:

"I saw young children competently working in small groups, one as a leader, one as a reporter/recorder using a white board and one providing feedback on how to make improvements- amazing!!!! Other pupils were using ipads to record progress and support evaluation and feedback. I don't think I've seen this competence with such young pupils by such an inexperienced teacher ever — she was adamant it has happened because of the support, planning, resources and mentoring she has received from both the subject leader and sports coach"




Impact on our staff...
